Private Attorney Panel, Request for Applications

Due to concerns raised regarding the increasing number of appointments for juvenile representation, I am requesting that all attorneys who may be interested in being included on the panel for indigent representation please submit an application. While we welcome applications for any of the five panels (Criminal Felony, Criminal Misdemeanor, Juvenile, Guardian Ad Litem, and Appellate), the greatest need for attorneys at the moment is for the <u>Juvenile panel</u>. The application procedure, application form, and membership requirements can be found in the Local Rules for the Superior Court, Miscellaneous Rule 1.1.
