




RENEWAL of Certification (§§ G)


- Certification Valid for 3 years
- •Renewal Application must be submitted
- •Once submitted, certification does not expire until the PJ approves or denies the certification
- •If application is DENIED, the certification does not expire until the last day to seek a hearing on the denial
- •Renewal applications filed after the expiration of the certificate will be treated as new applications
- •Renewal provisions DO NOT affect Disciplinary Actions
- •Notification of DENIED Renewal application is provided

Private Process Server Program





- •See §§ G(17)

Re-Hearing

- •REquest must be made to Hearing Officer 15 Days after Order was mailed or delivered
- •Response permitted within 15 Days
- •Decision by Hearing Officer in 30 Days of Request

Orders

- •Rederred 30 Days after closing of hearing
- •Fidnings of Fact
- •Conclusions of Law
- •If Suspension or Revocation is determined, then Notice to Certificate Holder will be provided and the Chief Marshal shall within 10 Days inform the Clerk of Court and the Program Coordinator
